Introduction [Whole class]

Reference to Game: Tike finds his dog in the CCTV control room.

Introduce the issue of CCTV.

Where do we find CCTV?

What advantages are there for its use in school? [Security] Are there any disadvantages? [Distrust]

Are there alternative ways to monitor the school environment?

Activities for Individual and Group Work
