Myth Mixer

1. With a partner work out some 'they say' and 'we say' responses about your school using the Myth Mixer or keyboard to make a suitable rhythm.

- a) Develop your ideas into a rap giving the school a positive image.
- b) Either perform your rap to the class or make a video of your performance.

2. It is often difficult to change people's perception of someone or something with a bad reputation or negative image.

- a) How many fictional 'bad' characters can you think of? Make a list and note down what you feel makes them bad.
- b) Take a well known 'bad' character from a book or a film and develop a plot which will change him/her into a character with a positive image.
E.g Dracula could become a blood donor in an attempt to save lives. The 'big bad wolf' could open a home for 'down and out' pigs.
- c) Either present your plot as a storytelling performance to the class or use a tape recorder to present an extract from your plot as a radio play or story tape.
